



## iOS 9 Hotspot/Tethering Instructions

### Wi-Fi Hotspot iOS 9:

1. Go to Settings
2. Go to Cellular Data
3. Select Personal Hotspot (it will say off)
4. Touch the slider next to Personal Hotspot to turn it on
5. If Wi-Fi is off, it will ask you to turn it on.
6. The hotspot is now active. On the client device, use the network name and password given on the Personal Hotspot screen to connect.
7. Follow the on screen directions to complete your connection

### USB Tethering iOS 9:

1. Prepare the computer with the necessary drivers:
  - a. Windows: install the latest version of iTunes, which includes the drivers
  - b. OS X: supported natively
  - c. Linux: supported natively in most distributions released after mid-2012. Other distributions may have to manually install the correct packages, such as ipheth-utils
2. Prepare the iOS device for Personal Hotspot:
  - a. Go to Settings
  - b. Go to Cellular Data
  - c. Select Personal Hotspot (it will say off)
  - d. Touch the slider next to Personal Hotspot to turn it on
  - e. If Wi-Fi is off, it may ask you to turn it on – It doesn't matter what you select here
3. Plug in the iOS device to the computer
  - a. You will get a popup on the iOS device; select "Trust"
4. Wait for the computer to recognize the device as a new network connection. Depending on your operating system, you may or may not see anything happen.

The Internet should now be available on the computer; turn Wi-Fi off, open a web browser, and verify that you can view web pages
