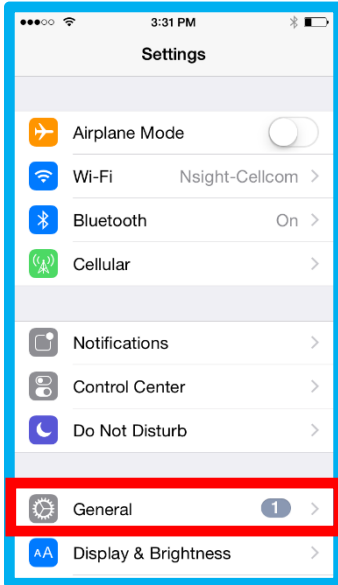
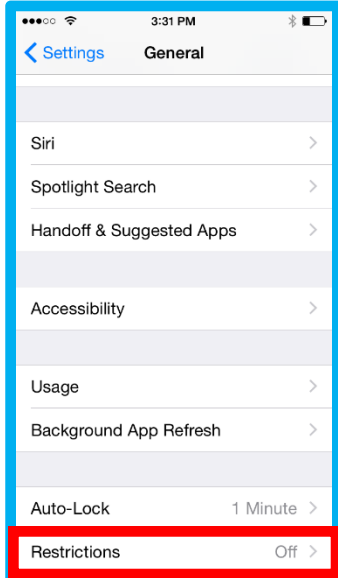


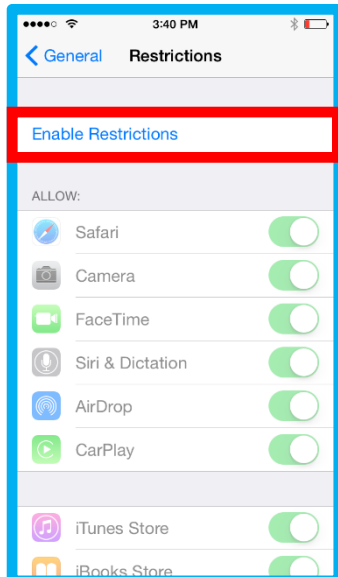
Setting up iPhone Restrictions



1. Tap the “Settings” icon and click on “General.”

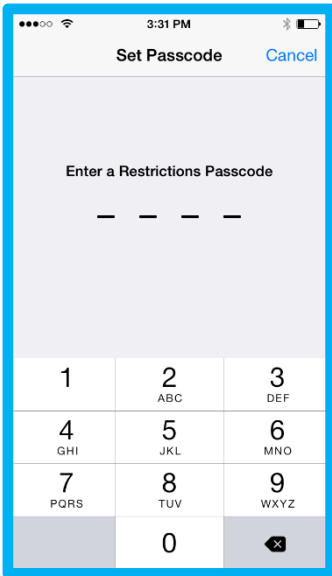


3. Tap “Restrictions.”

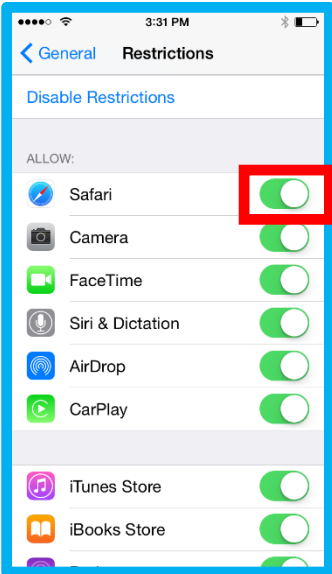


2. Tap “Enable Restrictions.”

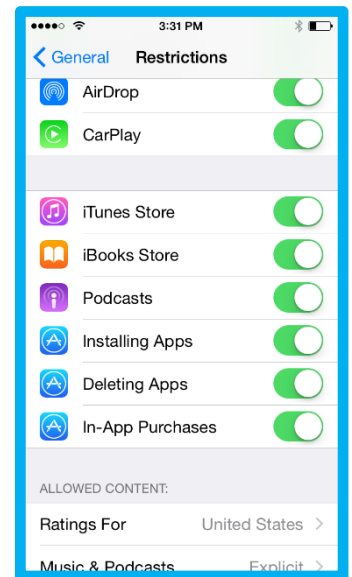

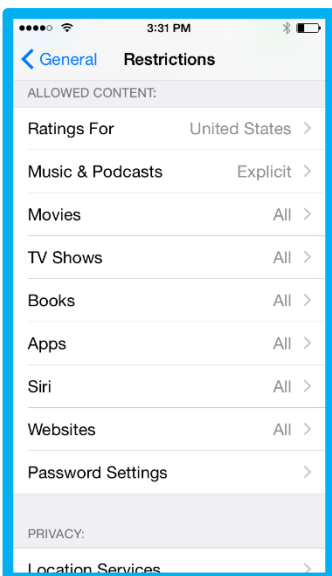
4. Create a Restrictions Passcode. Use this passcode to change settings for restrictions.



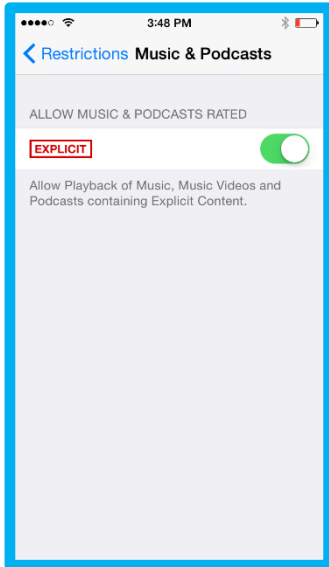
5. As a default, there are no application restrictions. To restrict access to any applications displayed, tap the green button on the right hand side of the application. The button will turn gray if access is restricted.



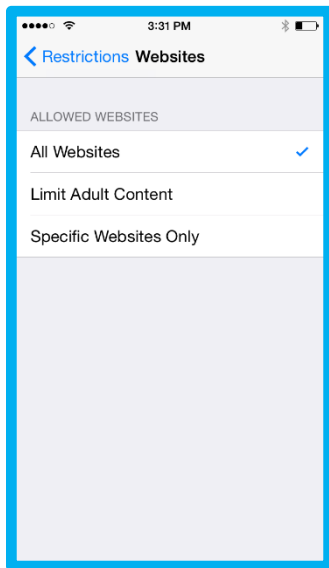
6. Scroll further down the list to set up content rating restrictions. This would include restrictions for content based on the user's age.



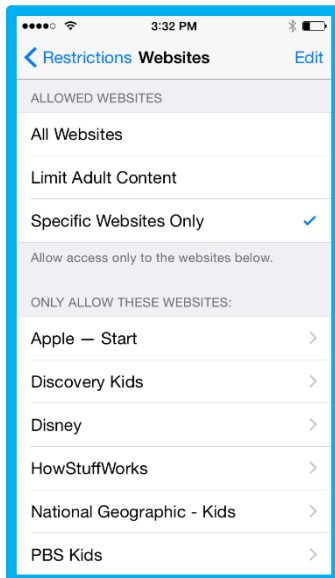
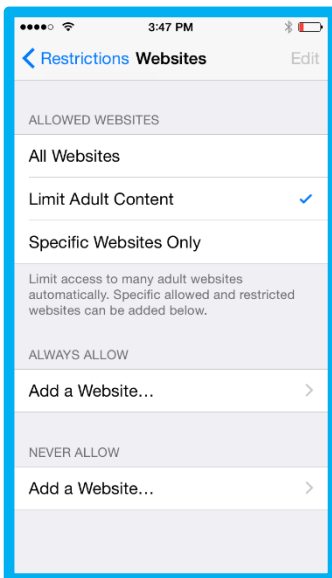

7. For “Music & Podcasts” tap the green button to restrict playback of music, music videos and podcasts that contain explicit content.



8. For “Websites”, there are three options:
 - a. Allow all websites
 - b. Limit Adult Content
 - c. Allow Specific Websites Only



9. Tap “Limit Adult Content” or “Specific Websites Only” to set up restrictions for websites.
 - a. “Limit Adult Content” – Limit access to many adult websites automatically. Specific allowed and restricted websites can be added.
 - b. “Specific Websites Only” – Allow access to only the websites that are added.
